

Paper Plate Chicken

Materials —

2 paper plates cardstock (red, yellow) wiggle eyes pipe cleaners scissors glue pencil tape



Directions —

- 1. Fold a paper plate in half to create the body of the chicken.
- 2. Draw a triangle shape on yellow cardstock to create a beak.
- 3. Draw an oval shape on red cardstock to create wattle.
- 4. Draw a wiggly shape on red cardstock to create a comb.
- 5. Draw a triangle shape with three half circle shapes at the top for the tail.
- 6. Draw half heart shapes to create wings on another paper plate.
- 7. Cut out each shape from the cardstock and paper plate.



- 8. Glue the yellow beak to the underside of the folded paper plate near the folded line.
- 9. Glue the red wattle just under the beak to the folded paper plate.
- 10. Glue the red comb to the outside top fold of the paper plate.
- 11. Glue the wings to the outside middle of the folded paper plate (one wing per side).
- 12. Glue the wiggly eyes on the outside edge near the beak (on each side).
- 13. Glue the tail to the outside of the folded paper plate at the opposite end of the wiggly eyes.
- 14. Cut a pipe cleaner in half.
- 15. Fold the cut pipe cleaner into three sections.
- 16. Attach one section to the paper plate using a piece of tape.
