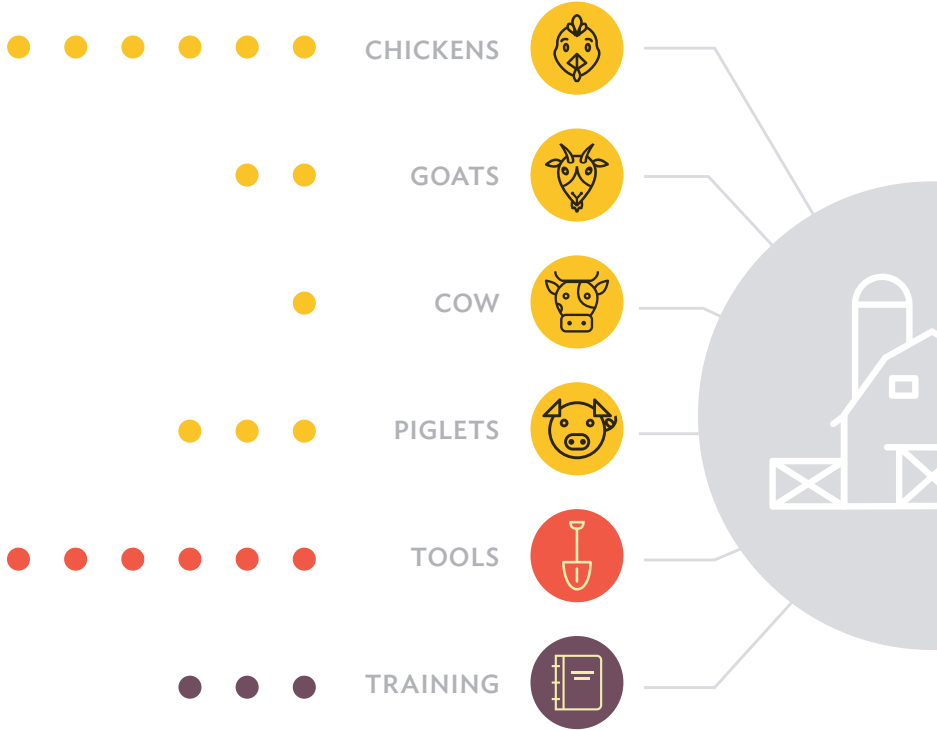

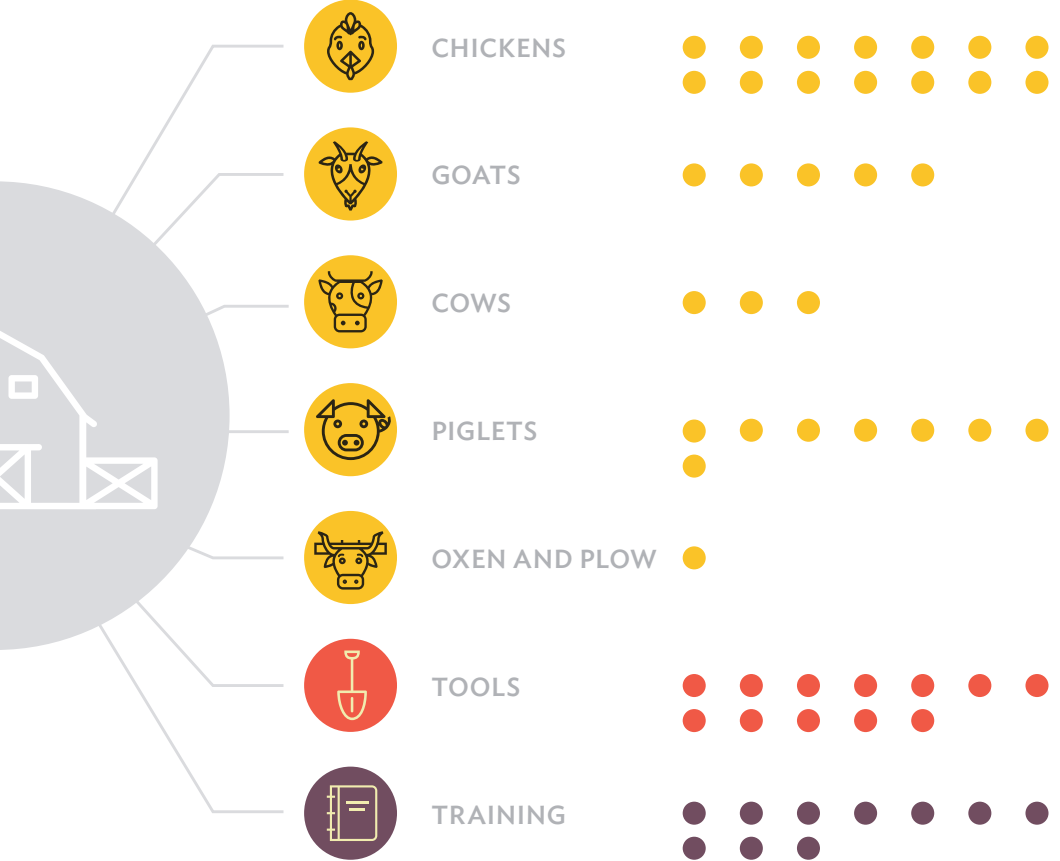


**Community Farm Bundle** ITEM OG10033

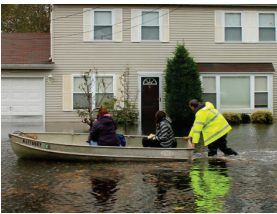
### Famine Relief Food Voucher ITEM OG10036 **\$50**

In times of famine and extreme hunger, emergency food is a necessity, but prepackaged food relief from foreign agencies can undermine local food systems, contributing to long-term issues of food insecurity. These vouchers can be redeemed with local vendors, helping to nourish the population and strengthen the area's food system.

In parts of the world, clean water can only be found hundreds of feet below the surface, in uncontaminated aquifers that do not run dry, despite scorching conditions and minimal rainfall. Deep rock wells are created to be sustainable, intentionally placed in areas where they can do the most good and be maintained by trained community members.



## Community Irrigation Water Pump

Once an agricultural hub, the northeast region of Nigeria has been ravaged by civil unrest that has damaged land and equipment, and made farms inaccessible. This, combined with an extended dry period, has led to widespread food insecurity and economic instability. A community irrigation water pump helps farmers restore their land and make it fruitful again.



## Rainwater Catchment System

Rainwater can be a precious resource when collected, stored and filtered properly. Help communities collect usable water for irrigation and washing with a rainwater catchment system.

## Discover how a small women-owned bakery is making a big impact in rural Malawi

The Kasupe Women’s Bakery, a partner of the Presbyterian Hunger Program and supported, in part, by gifts made through the Presbyterian Giving Catalog, provides much-needed income for women while also producing a variety of nutritious, healthy food for their community. The bakery doesn’t just empower women by employing them as bakers — it is bolstering the production of local farmers and strengthening the economy by sourcing local ingredients for their baked goods.

Because of this livelihood project, 109 women are shareholders in the bakery, earn \$11 per month, and have more financial resources to support their families, which is improving access to education, healthcare and basic necessities like food and clothing. The progress they’ve made is a source of hope and inspiration for the resilient women of Kasupe. The project is designed to grow alongside the community, offering increased opportunities as production expands. Our ultimate goal is to continuously move toward sustainable and fair wages.

*“The Kasupe Women’s Bakery hasn’t given me everything, but it is putting food on the table,”* said Tinenenji Kalamba, a bakery shareholder.

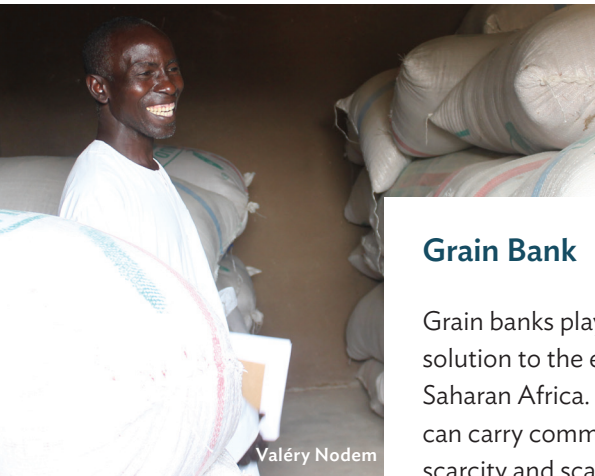
